Kyley Dickson, PH.D.

Dr. Dickson Is a researcher at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville, where his work focuses on advancing athletic field safety and performance. Additionally, he serves as the Executive Director of the Alliance for Low Input Sustainable Turf (A-LIST), a position he has held since 2022. In this role, he leads efforts to promote as well as identify environmentally sustainable and high-performing turfgrass varieties.


